A Friendly Reminder About Assisted Living/Medicaid Waiver

The transition to a residential community is a daunting process and there is a lot of information given to you during this time, so we know you're not going to remember everything. Oakleaf Village is an approved community for the Ohio Assisted Living Waiver program. This is a program that you can apply for to get assistance with your rent when you realize you will be running out of your private funds. Here are some of the guidelines specific to Oakleaf Village of Toledo and the Assisted Living Waiver:

- · Residents must have a \$0.00 balance on their ledger at the time of application with the state
- · Residents will be required to move to a Medicaid Certified studio unit, if available. Residents are responsible for taking care of all arrangements and charges regarding such a move.
- · When you determine that you are approximately six (6) months from running out of personal funds, you must reach out to the Business Office Manager to get the information to call and order an application packet from the Area Office on Aging. You will be given additional information from the Business Office Manager at this time that is beneficial to the application and assessment process.
